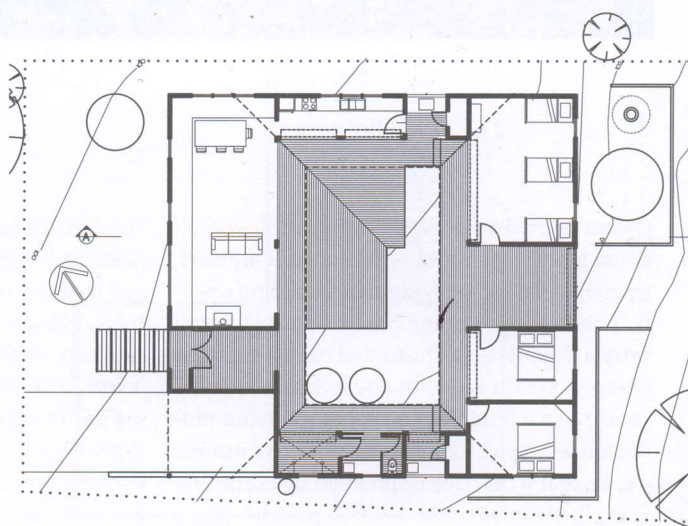

V avstralskem deskarskem mestecu Seal Rocks se je nekega dne pojavila hiša brez hodnikov, rahlo dvignjena od tal in lahko obložena v aluminij, z imenom Mirtin grm («kurreki», v jeziku worimi).

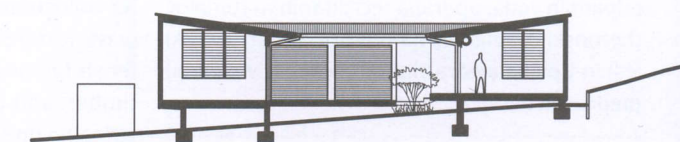
Namenjena je počitku, zato šaljivo in s čudovito preprostostjo reducira vse elemente stanovanjske stavbe in poudari lahkotnost bivanja, povzemajoč logiko kampa. Garaža je le odprta vrzel med hišo in tlemi, sobe pa so z garažnimi vrati oddeljene od dvorišča. Okoli tega glavnega bivalnega središča se hiša organizira. Prehodnost med sobami, kopalnico, kuhinjo s prostorom za žar in dnevno sobo je pogojena z izhodom na prosto. Širok vhodni foyer je namenjen odlaganju desk za srfanje in opremljen s prho, ki se lahko nemoteno uporablja, saj je z zavesico oddeljena od dvorišča. Na strehi se šopirijo sončne celice. Vodni rezervoarji, ki se nemoteno pojavljajo kot element znotraj ali zunaj hiše, pa hranijo vodo tako za vsakodnevno uporabo kot tudi za primer požara. Vse tako preprosto. Kdo bi potreboval kaj več?

In the Australian surfer town of Seal Rocks, a house appeared one day, slightly lifted off the ground and clad in light aluminium. It's name - myrtle bush ("kurreki" in the worimi language). Meant for rest and leisure, it playfully and with wonderful simplicity reduces all the elements of a residential building, emphasizing the ease of living by summing up the logic of camping. The garage is merely an open gap between the house and the ground, while the rooms are divided from the courtyard by age doors.

It is around this courtyard, that the house is organized. The transitions between the rooms, the bathroom, kitchen with a barbecue space and the living room are all based on moving outdoors. A broad entrance foyer is intended for dropping off surfboards and equipped with a shower that can be used freely, as it is only separated from the courtyard with a curtain. Solar panels inhabit the roof. Water tanks, which appear undisturbed both inside and outside the house, keep the water for both daily use and extinguishing fires. All so simple. Who could ever need more?
